

## Feedback Analysis (Session 2023-24)

Based on feedback forms, analysis has been conducted on course content, faculty, and alumni feedback. The results indicate that 100% of the parents and students are satisfied with the curriculum provided by the institution. Additionally, the curriculum ensures the provision of practical knowledge, which has been highly appreciated.

A total of 100% of alumni, faculty, and students agree that the curriculum and the college provide practical knowledge, including facilities like the library.

The feedback percentages are as follows:

- 33% rated it as excellent,
- 33% rated it as very good, and
- 33% rated it as good.

Regarding records and audio/visual/computer facilities, 44% of the feedback was positive. Among these, 22% rated it as excellent, and another 22% rated it as very good. Only 1% of parents expressed dissatisfaction with the computer facilities.

For regular classes, the feedback is as follows:

- 66% rated them as excellent,
- 22% rated them as very good, and
- 11% rated them as good.

No one expressed dissatisfaction.

In sports activities, everyone is satisfied. The feedback includes:

- 55% rated it as very good, and
- 33% rated it as excellent.

Other aspects like cleanliness and campus maintenance are good, and no dissatisfaction has been noted.

For extracurricular activities, the feedback is satisfactory across the board, with no one reporting dissatisfaction or the need for improvements.

- 33% rated it as very good, and
- 33% rated it as good.


Canteen facilities, along with feedback from parents, alumni, students, and faculty, are mostly rated positively.


Feedback Summary:



1. Alumni contributions have increased compared to last year. During functions and lectures, the college now invites alumni to participate and strengthen the bond between alumni and the institution.


2. In some feedback, it was noted that 10% of respondents are not satisfied with the canteen facilities in the college.
