Project Scope:

2. Deliverables:

- **One Short Films:** 2 Film should be 3-4 minutes in duration.
- Social Media Reels: 4 reels designed for platforms such as Instagram and Facebook.

3. Editing and Finalization:

- The editing process should involve close consultation with the person designated by Vidya Bhawan.
- All edits and revisions should reflect the inputs and approval of Vidya Bhawan's representative.

4. Timeline:

- Start Date: January 2025
- Final Submission: All deliverables must be completed and submitted by 15th March 2025.

Eligibility Criteria:

- 1. Experience:
 - The agency or individual must demonstrate a minimum of **8 years** of prior experience in professional film production and education sector.
 - Team members involved in the project must also individually have a minimum of **8 years** of relevant experience.

• New agencies with a team collectively having a minimum of **8 years** of experience will also be considered.

2. Portfolio Submission:

• Applicants must provide a portfolio showcasing prior work in producing films and reels, preferably in the education or social development sectors.

3. Technical Proficiency:

- Proven expertise in shooting, editing, and post-production processes.
- Familiarity with creating content suitable for both short films and social media formats.

Core Idea of the Initiative: The "Books for Friends Initiative" seeks to:

- Ensure every child in a group (such as a school grade or a group of friends) receives at least one children's book per cycle.
- Encourage children to exchange and read each other's books, creating an affordable and efficient method for book access.
- Foster accountability and a sense of responsibility towards books among children.
- Build a sustainable, community-driven reading culture that enhances literacy and lifelong learning.

Expected Impact: This initiative is more than a reading program; it is a movement to build an ecosystem that fosters a love for reading and education. It aims to develop a scalable model that addresses immediate literacy needs while contributing to a culturally rich, sustainable reading environment.

- 2. Quality and creativity of previous work.
- 3. Feasibility and clarity of the proposed plan.
- 4. Cost-effectiveness.
