

## **Feed back analysis [ 2024-25 ]**

### **Alumini feedback**

Vidya Bhavan Rural Institute's IQAC cell designed a feedback form for old students, based on which suggestions were collected and improvements were made in the college for the session 2024–25.

The feedback form was distributed to all old students and working students of the institute. Based on their feedback, improvements in water facilities, electricity, cleanliness, and other areas were made. Around 70% of old students rated the college as "Very Good," 30% rated it as "Good," and no negative opinions were expressed.

90% of old students stated that the feedback form initiative was a positive step. Based on their suggestions, programs like seminars, workshops, special lectures, and other activities will be conducted. Old students' feedback has proven helpful for the institution's development.

The feedback initiative will also be used for further institutional progress. This feedback form initiative included 100% of the students from the Rajasthan Military Academy School Staff (2021 batch) and other graduates.

We are planning to organize an event where the old students can share their experiences with the current students. Around 90% of the old students talk about the memories of early morning chemistry practical classes, the first day of college, hostel life, and Holi festivals, which still remain fresh in their minds.

Suggestions can be collected from old students through feedback forms.


- Use social media platforms such as YouTube, Facebook, and WhatsApp to connect with old students and provide them with updates about the event.

- Another suggestion is to invite old students to college functions where they have **the opportunity to reconnect and share their achievements with the college** community.


### Feedback Analysis Summary

From the feedback analysis, it has been observed that the old students consider this college to be one of the best colleges under MLSU. Along with this, the college is recognized as one of the best institutions providing quality education at a minimal cost.



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**Faculty Feedback Report**

Feedback was collected from all faculty members. 21 responses were collected out of which 7 from Arts, 1 from Commerce and 13 from science stream. On the basis of response collected it was found that 52% faculty feels that College encourages them for the participation in designing and developing of Curriculum at University level. Some faculty members of Commerce, History and Analytical Chemistry have suggested changes in course at University level. In these subjects, University implemented their suggestions.

85.71% responded that the syllabus is as per the requirement of industry. Majority of faculty rated the infrastructure facility of College as average. 76% of the faculty were in the favor that they receive benefits like CL, PL, AL, Medical leave along with salary. Faculty members feel that College does not provide financial support to faculty members for research, seminar, FDP or conference.

Basic amenities like potable water, clean toilets available in the campus are average. They responded that they have freedom to adopt new techniques of teaching. Learning resources available in College library are good according to 76%, average according to 23%. Faculty members rated their teaching as very good and 47% rated as good. 71.4% rated that their Head of the Institute listens and solves their problem.

**Action taken on the basis of Feedback Collected:**

1. Industrial and Lab visits are organized in Chemistry and Commerce department so that the students can learn about the techniques, instruments used in Industry. It will help in preparing the students as per the need of Industry.
2. Infrastructure facilities were increased in College like smart classrooms were prepared. Ramps and railings, toilets with railing support were made for Divyangjan.
3. Some fund was approved in Budget for providing financial support to faculty for attending conferences.



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## Feedback Analysis Report (2024-25)

Based on the feedback form, analysis has been done on the parents' feedback. Parents are satisfied with the infrastructure, computer lab, canteen, arrangement of classes, functioning of placement cell and co-curricular activities. 94% of the parents are satisfied that the current session was helpful in giving practical knowledge to the students.

About 49% of the parents rated the college library as very good, 46% as good and 5% as average.

43% of the respondents rated the infrastructure and computer laboratories as very good; 46% rated it as good; and 11 percent of parents rated it as average.

About 43% of parents rated the classroom system as very good, 40% rated it as good and 17% rated it as average.

51% of parents rated sports facilities and sports equipments as very good, 29% rated it as good and 20% rated it as average.

The feedback percentage of canteen facility is as follows

Very good - 37%

Good – 43%

Average -20%

About 46% of the parents rated the functioning of the Placement Cell as very good, 43% as good and 11% as average.

44% of parents rated the extracurricular activities at the college as very good, 37% as good and 9% as average. 91% of parents agreed that the college has basic facilities.

Is there any improvement in the skills, knowledge and morals of the student after admission to college - About 46% of the parents rated the improvement in the student as very good, 40% as good and 14% as average.



### Summary of analysis:

Feedback analysis shows that parents consider this college to be the best college in the city. Also, this college is considered to be one of the best institutions providing quality education at the lowest cost. The college has adequate facilities of library, laboratory and playground. Apart from regular teaching, attention is also paid here to the fact that the students develop their personality in a multidimensional way, understand the problems of their region, society and today and work properly towards their solution.
