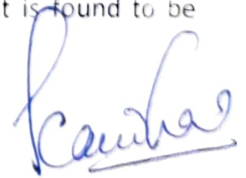

The Director, VBRI will be the chairperson of this committee. A complaint from an aggrieved student relating to the institution shall be addressed to the Chairperson, Student Grievance Redressal Committee (SGRC). The committee will follow following procedure to redress the grievance -

- Any aggrieved student may submit an application seeking redressal of grievance through online portal of the Institute.
- The Student Grievance Redressal Committee, as the case may be, shall fix a date for hearing the complaint which shall be communicated to the institution and the aggrieved student within 15 days of receipt of complaint.
- An aggrieved person may appear either in person or authorize a representative to present his/her case.
- Grievances not resolved by the Student Grievance Redressal Committee shall be referred to the Ombudsperson of the affiliating M.L.S. University, within the time period provided in Regulations (F.No.1-101/PGRC/AICTE/Regulation/2019 dated 07.11.2019).
- Institution and the Student Grievance Redressal Committee shall extend co-operation to the Ombudsperson.
- The Ombudsperson shall, after giving reasonable opportunities of being heard to both parties, on the conclusion of proceedings, pass such order, with reasons therefore as may be deemed fit to redress the grievance and provide such relief as may be appropriate to the aggrieved student.
- The Institution, as well as the aggrieved student, shall be provided with copies of the order under the signature of the Ombudsperson, and the institution shall place it for general information on its website.
- The Institution shall comply with the recommendations of the Ombudsperson. The Ombudsperson may recommend appropriate action against the complainant, where a complaint is found to be false or frivolous.

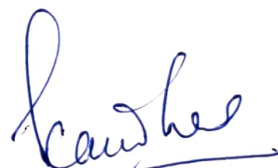
